

Art/Pottery March Break Camp 2020

Welcome to another fabulous March Break at the Glebe Community Centre with Art/Pottery Camp! Below are a few reminders to help you and your child have a great week at camp. Absence

If your child will be absent please let us know before 8:00 am that day by phone at 613-233-8713 or by email at attendance@gnag.ca.

Getting Messy

In Art/Pottery camp we will be working everyday with a variety of art mediums including non-toxic acrylic paint and clay. Please send your child in clothes that can get stained everyday. We also recommend a messy shirt to wear for the big projects!

Drop off and Pick Up

Drop off is at 9:00 am and pick up at 4:00 pm at Glebe CC in the Pottery Studio.

Pre-Care and Post-Care

Children ages 4-12 may attend. Children attending pre and post care will be walked to and from their camp homeroom by staff. You can book online, in person or by phone (no online registration after start date).

Pre-care (\$20 for the week) is located in the Main Hall from 8:00 - 9:00 am daily. It is a free-play area, with different counsellors every day providing interactive supervision.

Post-care (\$45 for the week or \$12 daily) is located at the Glebe CC from 4:00 - 6:00 pm daily. It is a structured activity time with programmed games, crafts and quiet time, with different counsellors every day providing interactive supervision.

Allergies/Special Needs/Medications

Participants with allergies, special needs or medications may need to fill out extra forms. Please email Ali in advance for forms and details.

What to bring?

Don't forget to bring: 2 nut free snacks and lunch, indoor shoes, a messy shirt and weather appropriate clothing each day. *Please note: Children must have footwear on at all times in the Pottery Studio. Children without indoor shoes must wear their boots.*

Label EVERYTHING!

Label, label, label! Campers are responsible for all of their own belongings. We recommend labelling everything with the participants' full name. Please note: If a child loses something staff will do their

very best to help them find it, but ultimately it is their responsibility. Our lost and found is given to charity on a regular basis, so be vigilant about your child's belongings.
